Then, after many 28 years later, in 2012, another Francois, (Hollande) French President of the Republic appointed him foreign minister. Decidedly "Francois" is a good lucky charm to him and France's okay too, to lead this old house, a showcase of the finest French diplomacies. Manuel Valls Prime Minister also has greeted Laurent Fabius, at the chamber today, "This is an opportunity for me and the President of the Republic this morning at the council of ministers to greet Laurent Fabius. President Hollande offered him the position of Chairman of the Constitutional Council. He has both led a career of politician and of a State man, and especially his work at the head of French diplomacy. "This intervention about Laurent Fabius caused a first thunderous applause (Essentially deputies left).
